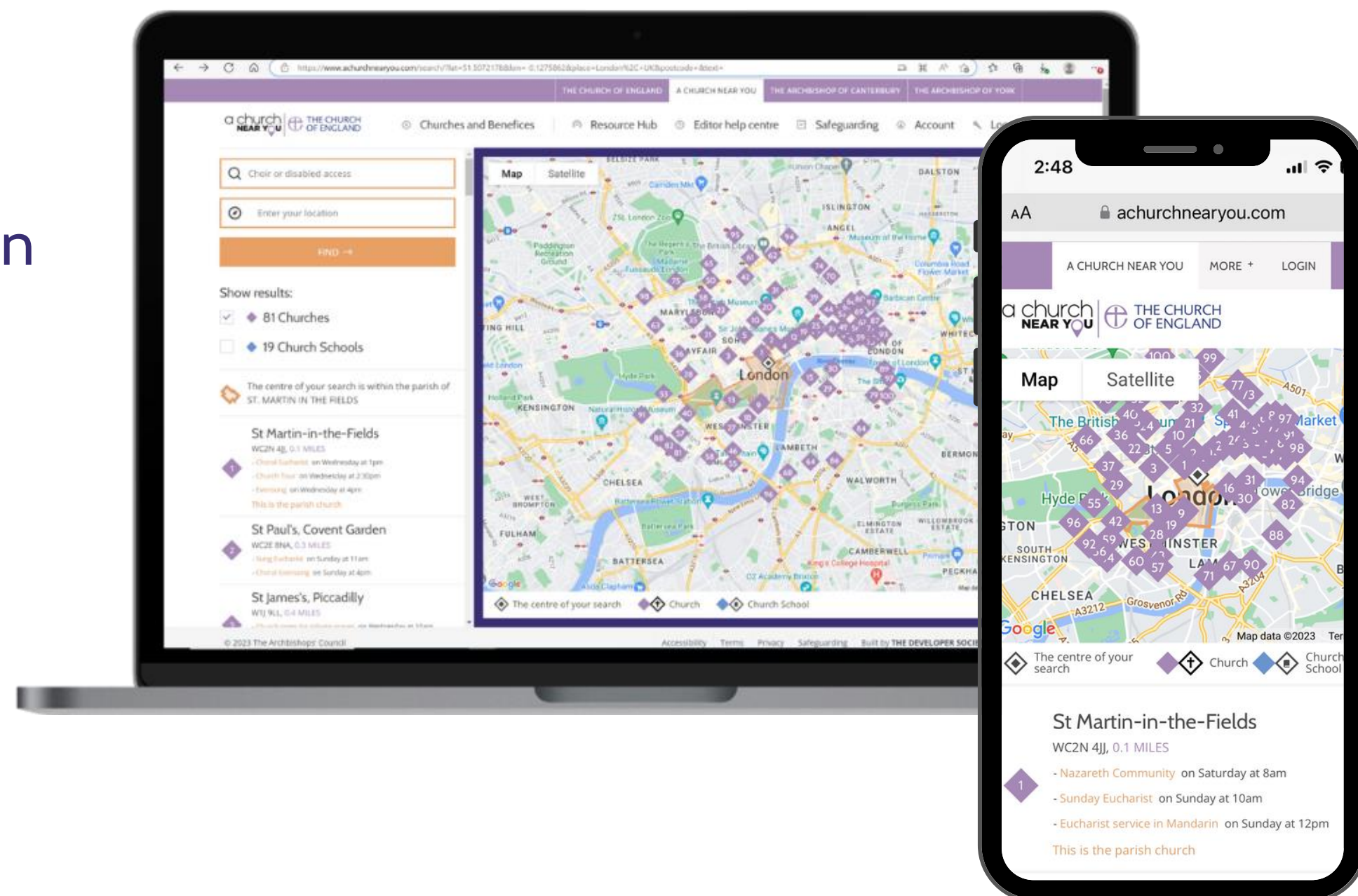

1. A church finder tool for the public:

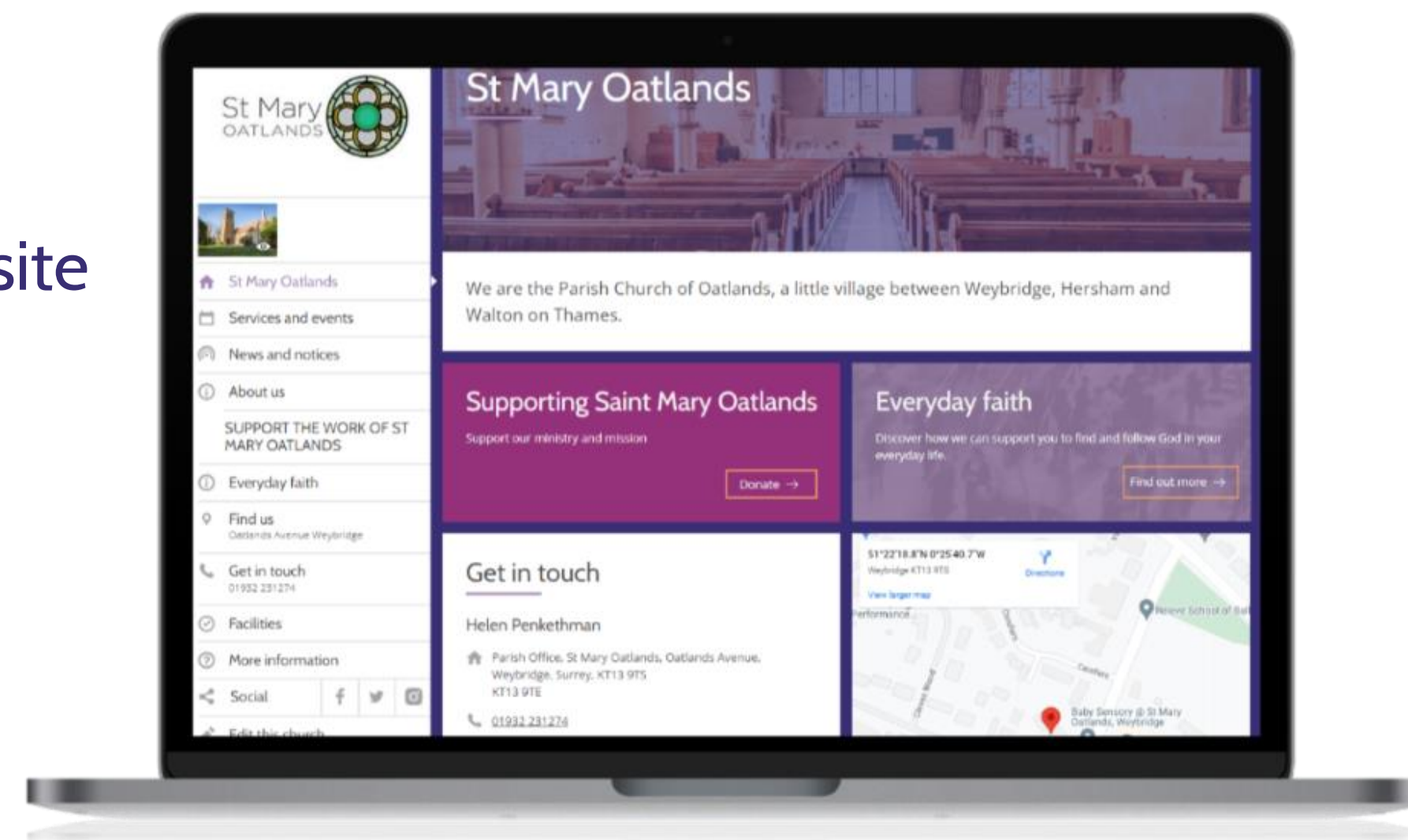
AChurchNearYou.com allows anyone to find their nearest church, view information about that church community and get in touch.



What is AChurchNearYou.com?

2. A free website platform for churches:

Every church or multi-church benefice can easily have their own free, easy to use website on AChurchNearYou.com.



How it works

Every Church of England church has a listing on AChurchNearYou.com, but it's up to you how you use it.

You have two options:

- 1. Keep your listing **short and simple** with a button to take people to your **separate church website**
- 2. Build out your listing into a **full website**, hosted within AChurchNearYou.com

If you want to, within AChurchNearYou.com you can also set up a website for your multi-church benefice, suitable if you are a Team Parish, Team Ministry or similar.

Why keep your listing up to date?

AChurchNearYou.com receives over 70 million page views per year. By keeping your church's listing up to date, you can benefit from this traffic and help more people find your church.

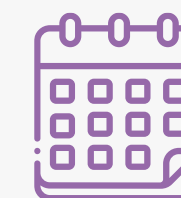

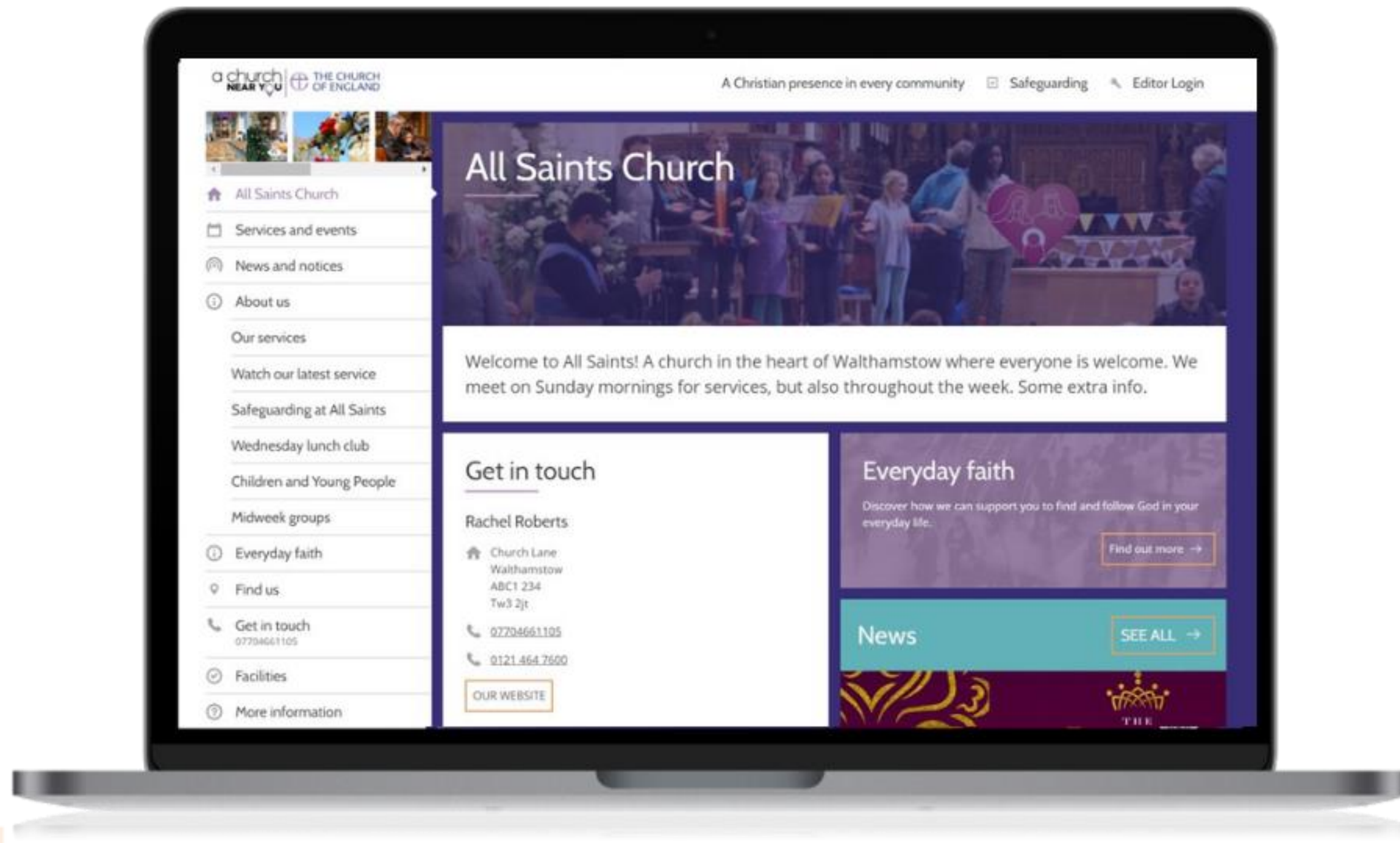

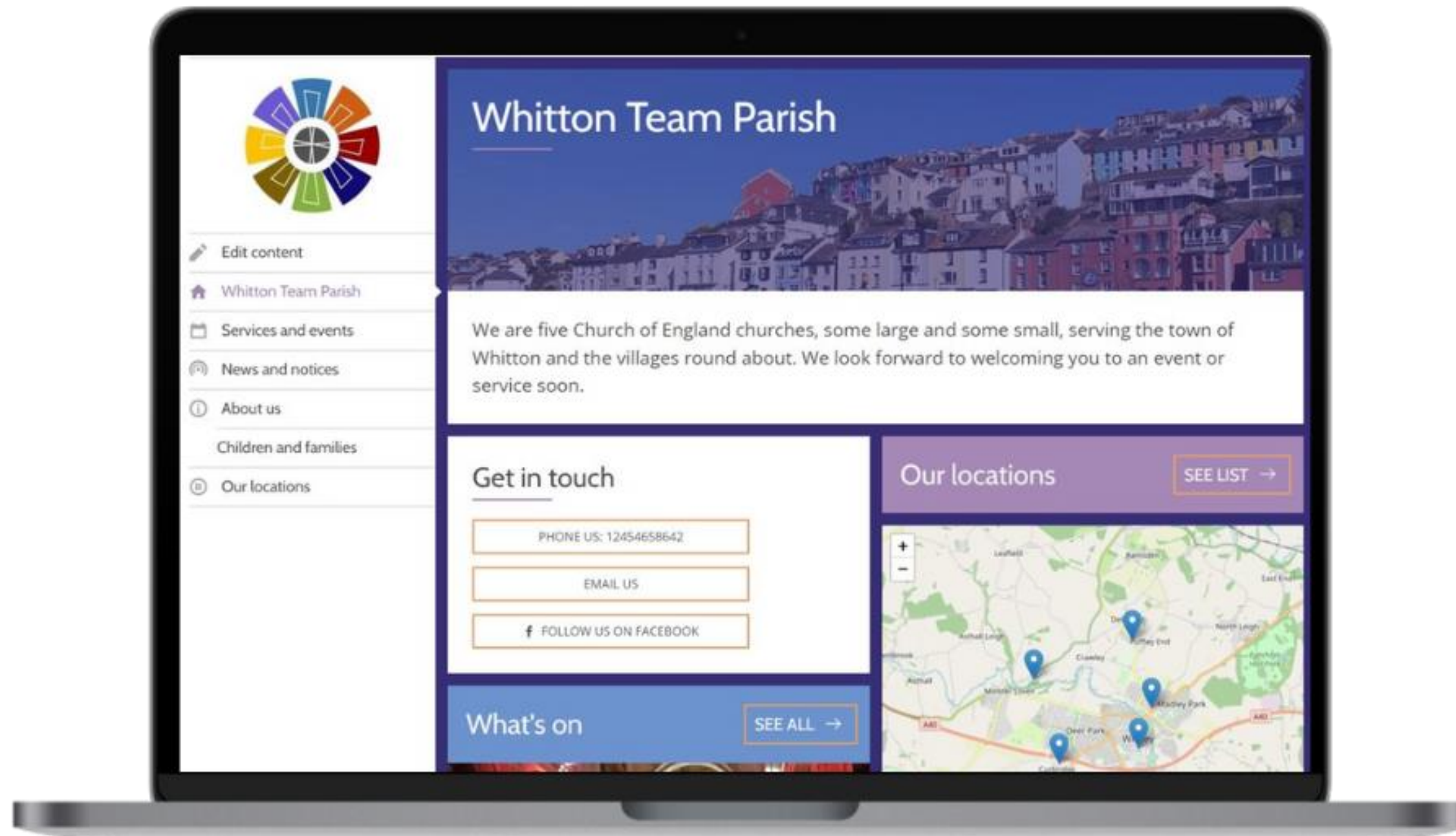

What will my website address (or URL) be?

The **default URL** will be something like achurchnearyou.com/church/12345

To customise the address, you can:

- **Contact us** and ask for an alternative URL with your church name in it, this will be in the format achurchnearyou.com/all-saints-millington.
- **Purchase a new custom URL**, for example, 'allsaintschurchmillington.org' from any domain name provider, and set it to forward to your AChurchNearYou.com URL.
- If you already have custom URL for a separate website, but want to move to AChurchNearYou.com, you can **redirect** it to your AChurchNearYou.com URL.

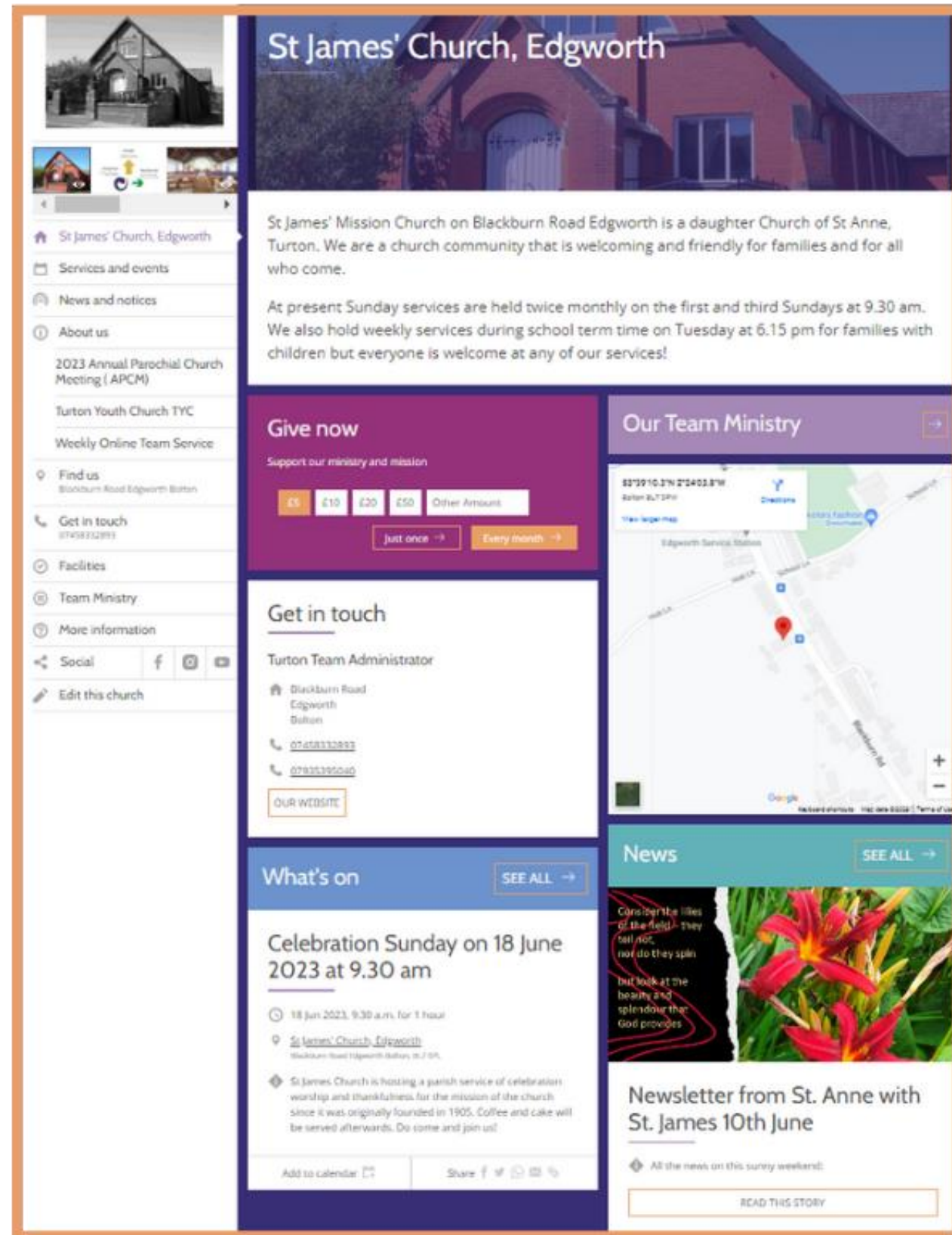

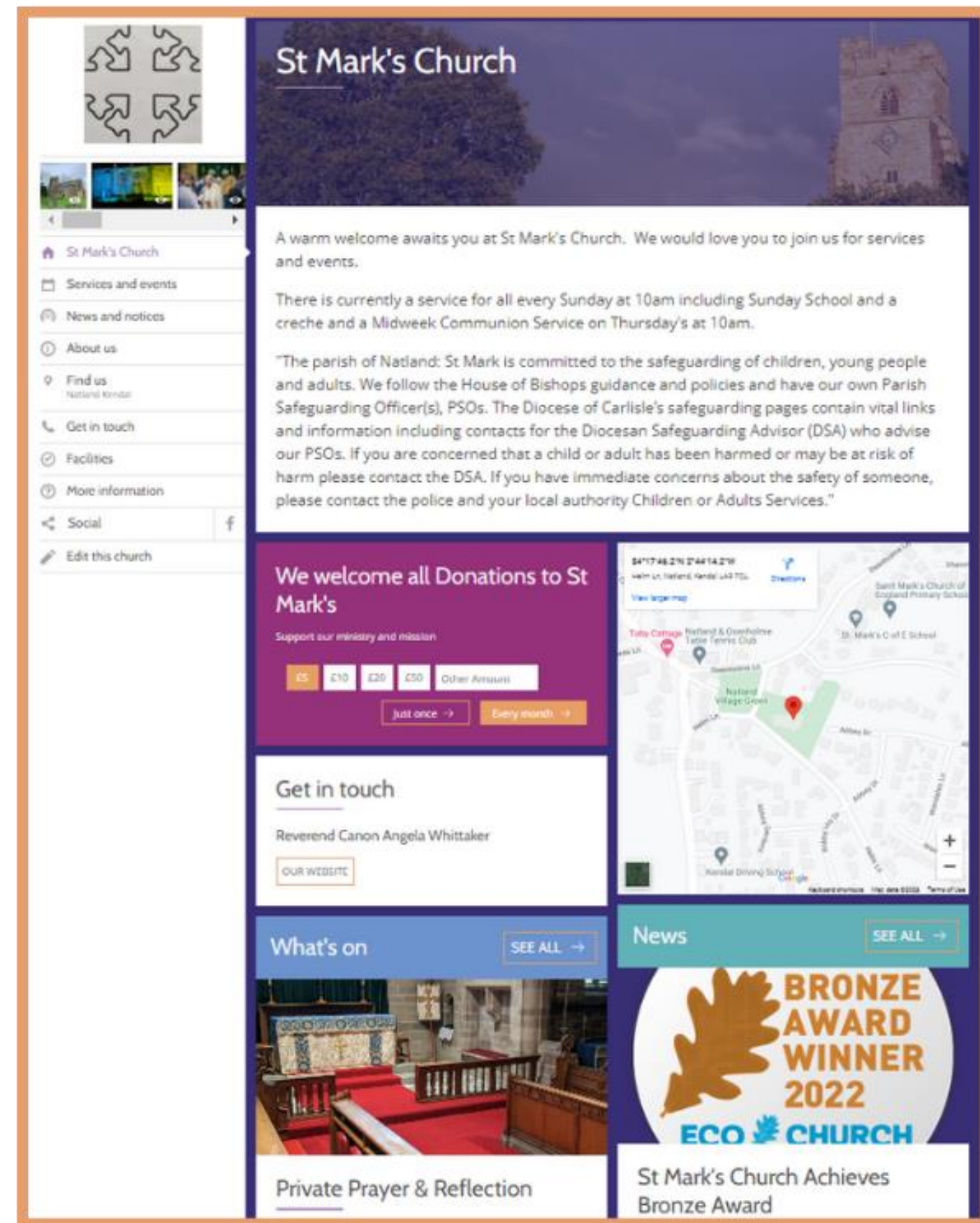



Opening

Our church is normally open from 9.00am to 5.00pm every day.

When visiting, please check the outside noticeboard (in the hedge on the corner of Park Road) for details of events that may be taking place.

In the run-up to major festivals (especially Easter, Harvest and Christmas) our Flower Team may be hard at work in the church, but visitors are still welcome.

Getting here

The entrance to our church is through a handsome historic wrought-iron gateway next to the old tollsey house on the corner of Park Road, Ludford - almost opposite the entrance to the car park of The Charlton Arms pub.

Car

There is one parking space immediately in front of the gates for the use of church staff, blue badge holders, hearses and wedding cars. If you are not in one of those categories please park either on the road from the bridge, alongside Ludford House, or else use the cemetery car park at the end of Park Road.

Train

Ludlow railway station is three-quarters of a mile away; about a 15 to 20-minute walk.

Bus

The nearest bus stop is just the other side of Ludford Bridge.

Taxi scheme for services

Some members of our congregation who do not have their own transport have set up a shared taxi scheme to get to and from St. Giles on Sundays. The cost is covered by a special fundraising programme. There is spare capacity if anyone wishes to join this scheme.

Disabled

For those who need help getting up the sloping path to the church for services we have a wheelchair and there are always willing pushers.

Features and facilities

- Accessibility**
 - TOILETS**: These are available when services are being held, but are not open every day for casual visitors. They are in our Garden House next to the church. Access is down two steps and up one step, so is not really suitable for wheelchairs, although we hope to address this problem soon.
 - DEFIBRILLATOR**: There is a defibrillator point at Ludlow Marriecare, just the other side of Ludford Bridge from the church, and a trained operator lives nearby.
 - HEARING (INDUCTION) LOOP**: Our loop system is used for all services. An amplifier is available for services with large congregations, and for outdoor celebrations; it also feeds into the loop system.
 - ASSISTANCE DOGS**: Guide dogs and other assistance dogs are always welcome at St. Giles.
- Our Building**
 - LISTED BUILDING**: St. Giles is Grade 2* listed, largely on account of its interesting memorials and brasses. Our handsome wrought-iron entrance gate is also listed.
- Music and Worship**
 - BELL-RINGING**: After a number of silent years, our single bell was brought back into use in 2018. It's sweet tone now floats out over the River Tern, welcoming parishioners making their way to the Sunday services.
 - BOOK OF COMMON PRAYER SERVICES**: Once or twice a month we have lay-led Morning Prayer services which usually include a number of prayers and psalms from the BCP.
- Groups, Courses and Activities**
 - BRASS RUBBING**: There are some very interesting memorial brasses in the Foxe Chapel of our church. During restoration work it was found that they were made from an even older brass memorial, and full details of this discovery can be found on the adjacent display board. A member of our congregation is an expert on old brasses in general.
- Help for Visitors**
 - CAR PARK / PARKING AVAILABLE**: There is one parking space immediately in front of the gates; this is for the use of church staff, blue badge holders, hearses and wedding cars. If you are not in one of those categories please park either on the road from the bridge, alongside Ludford House, or else use the cemetery car park at the end of Park Road.
 - RAMPED ENTRANCE**: Actually our entrance porch and doorway are not ramped because the floor is completely flat straight through so we don't need a ramp! The whole of the public area inside the church is step-free and carpeted.
 - LARGE PRINT**: Some large-print copies of our Mission Prayer hymnbooks are available. We also have some full-page magnifiers which can be borrowed for use with service books, Bibles, etc.
 - ORGAN**: For a small church we have an excellent modern organ. Our regular organist, Colin Reeves, conducts the Ludlow Town Band, and the local men's choir.

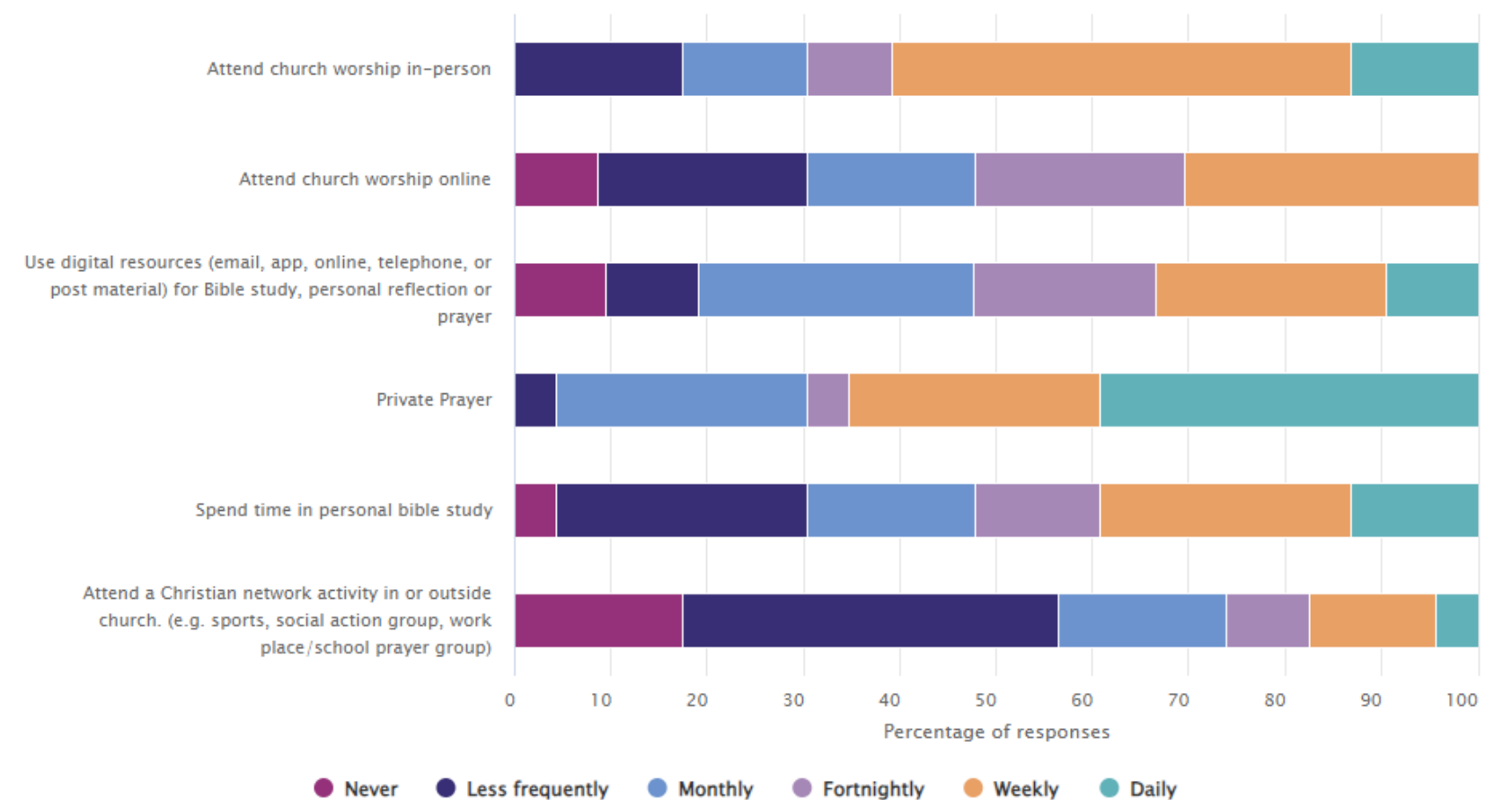

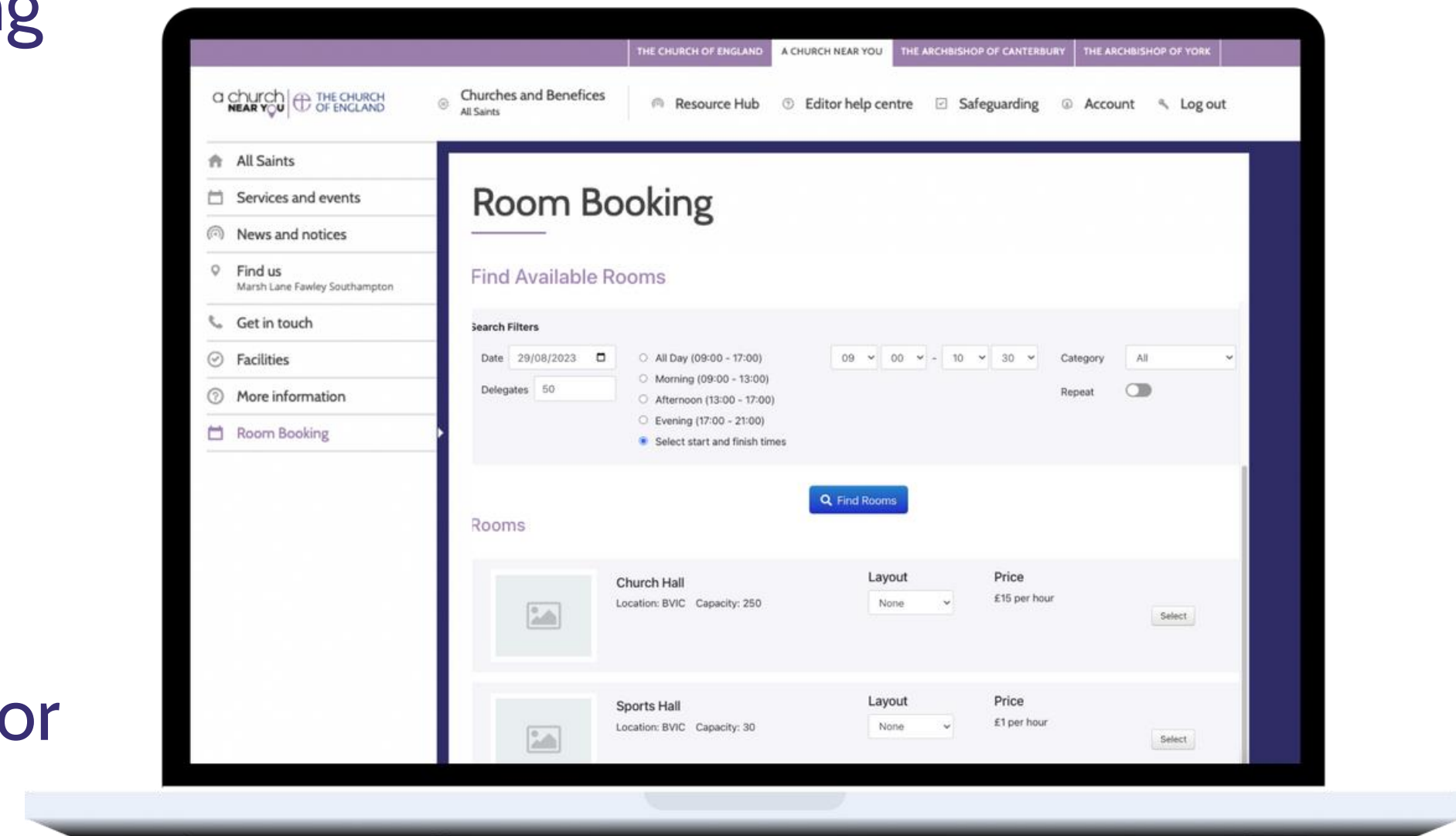


Room booking page

Connect your room bookings to your A Church Near You site to collect booking enquiries wherever you are, at any time of day.

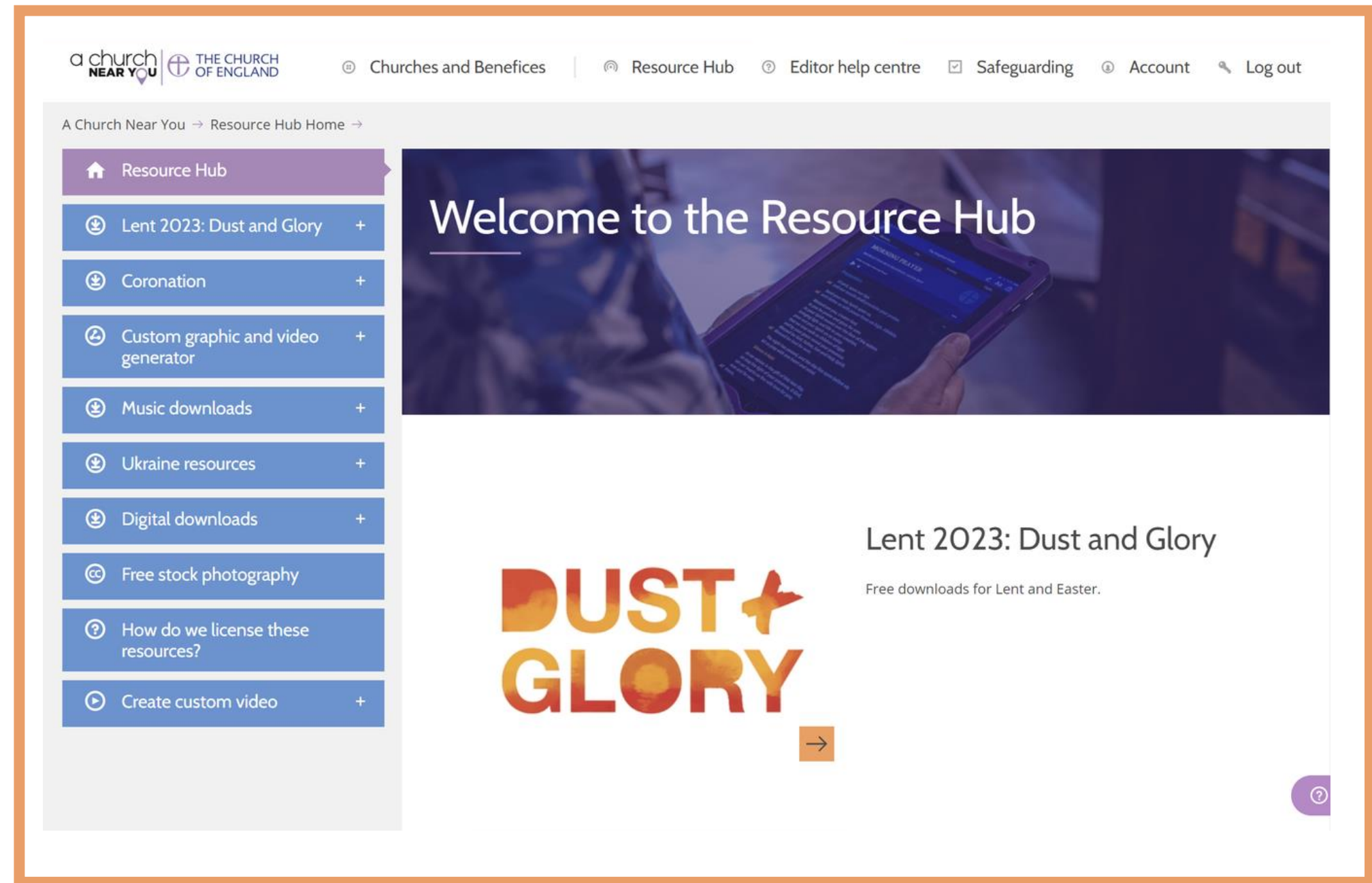
This allows people to view, book and pay for rooms directly on A Church Near You. Within The Church Organiser you will then be able to approve or decline bookings.
