

A PCC Guide to selecting someone for a Local Ministry Role

1. Consider:

In the light of their plan for growth, PCCs to consider if this form of ministry will help develop the mission and ministry of the benefice.

2. Communicate:

Incumbent contacts Mission and Ministry to register interest, communicates the idea of this role in the church and invites people to pray for those coming forward.

3. Explore:

Incumbent to complete the paperwork with the candidate and send it in. They will also need to discuss a role description and get formal approval from the PCC.

4. Recommend:

The candidate will be invited for a vocational conversation to explore their sense of calling and vocation to this role. A recommendation will be made on a way forward.

5. Authorise/Support:

If the person is recommended, they will be given guidance about how to can develop their unique vocation and calling. Following required training and checks they will be authorised locally.
