

Practical information and ideas for worship and fundraising for Kagera

In your church, benefice, deanery or group you could:

- Cook African food and host a meal, perhaps with a talk about Kagera. Look online for recipe ideas.
- Hold a Kagera service one Sunday in Lent. There are service templates and resources at www.cofesuffolk.org/kagera-link-diocese-resources
- Invite a speaker to a service or event – contact the coordinators to arrange a date.
- Decorate your church – African style.
- Take an extra collection at Lent services.
- In Kagera people sometimes bring goods to a service as their offering. After the service there is an auction. Why not give this a go?
- Encourage your congregation to use our Lent Challenge booklet, with daily reflection, prayer and giving ideas.
- Involve Sunday Schools and Youth groups. Why not set a specific challenge like 'buy (part of) a rainwater harvesting tank'?
- Sell Kagera notecards in your church. £4 for a pack of 5. Contact the coordinators for details.
