Leading a church school consists of 3 sessions over the school year. The sessions are cumulative and designed to build an understanding of what various aspects of Governance look like in the particular context of a church school, but could be used as standalones, depending on experience. The 3 sessions are:

- 1. Leading a church school understanding the day by day
- 2. Strategy and Leadership implementing change
- 3. Embedding the Christian Vision living the vision

Each session is designed to encourage and support governors by giving them an opportunity to explore what governance looks like day to day, in a church school context.

Session 1: Leading a church school – understanding the day by day

Being a governor of a church school is a rewarding challenge - you have the responsibilities of a community school governor and need to ensure that all that the school does is underpinned by a distinct Christian vision.

In this first session we will consider:

- What being a church school means
- Roles and responsibilities
- A distinct Christian vision

There will be two further sessions later in the year:

- Strategy and Leadership implementing change
- Embedding the Christian Vision living the vision

Session 2: Strategy and Leadership – implementing change Tuesday 9 March 2022, 4.00 – 5.30pm, via Zoom

In this second session we will explore effective strategies to enable governors and Headteachers to work together to:

- Identify what needs to change
- Implement and sustain change
- Overcome possible barriers

There will be one further session later in the year:

Embedding the Christian Vision – living the vision

Session 3: Embedding the Christian Vision - living the vision Tuesday 21 June 2022, 4.00 - 5.30pm, via Zoom

In this third session we will explore:

- Governance in a distinctively Christian church school
- Vision informed decision making
- How "difficult situations" can be managed
- SIAMS
