Leading a church school consists of 3 sessions over the school year. The sessions are cumulative and designed to build an understanding of what leadership looks like in a church school, but could be used as standalones, depending on experience. The three sessions are:

1. Leading a church school – understanding the day by day
2. Strategy and Leadership – implementing change
3. Embedding the Christian Vision – living the vision

Each session is designed to encourage and support new and aspiring church school leaders by giving them an opportunity to explore what that leadership looks like day to day, in a church school context.
