A Bishop is a leader in the Anglican Church.

They lead groups of churches and schools.

They also make important decisions about the whole church and help to support local charities and local communities.


Bishops lead services and spend a lot of their time praying for other people.



What does the Bible say about Bishops?



In the Book of Acts, chapter 20, verse 28 it says,
"Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God."

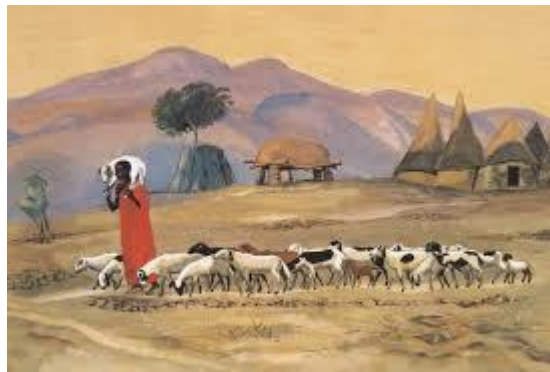


What does
a shepherd
do?

Who are
the flock?

A shepherd looks after a group or 'flock' of sheep. The Bible says that groups of Christians should have someone to help 'oversee' and look after them. That's what a Bishop does. The Bishop is like a shepherd and Christians are a flock.

In the Bible, **Jesus** is described as a "good Shepherd", so Bishops are following in Jesus' footsteps.



Bishop Joanne will watch over and care for people in Churches all over Suffolk. She will also visit schools.



Why did Bishop Joanne choose to become a Bishop?

I had a deep and powerful experience of Jesus sitting down next to me in a busy city church, reassuring me that all would be well, and promising to be alongside me. It was from that moment that I felt a sense of call to serve him.

I want to walk alongside young people as they find their own relationship with God, to acknowledge their joys and sorrows, and to see them grow into people who love and serve him in every area of their lives.



What does
a bishop
wear?



Look carefully: what can you see here?
Do you know what it's called?

It's called a 'dog collar'. It's a white band, worn around the neck which shows that someone works for the Anglican Church.

Look carefully again: What colour is
Bishop Joanne's shirt?

Bishops always wear a purple shirt
with their dog collar.





In Church services, Bishop Joanne might look a bit like this picture.

Look at the clothing the Bishop is **wearing**. Now look at what she is **carrying**.

What might this be?

It's a **mitre**.

A **mitre** is a tall hat, worn by bishops.

The front and back are the shape of a triangle.



This is a photograph of the Right Reverend Dr George Kotei Neequaye. He is a Bishop in the Anglican Church in Ghana.

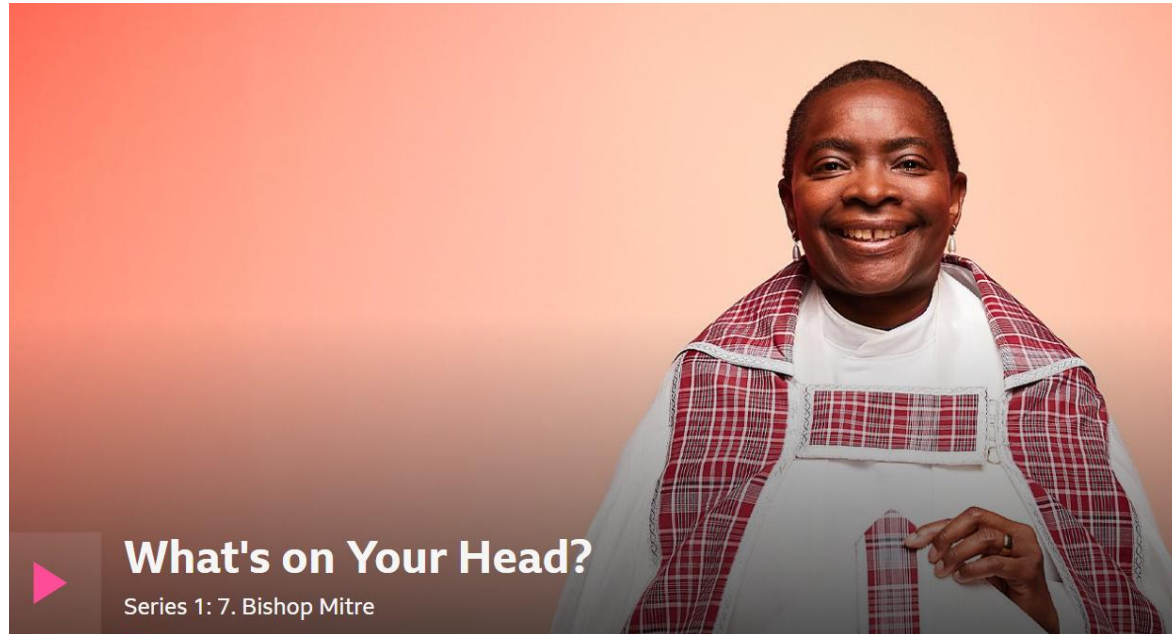
What is he holding in his left hand?

It's a **crozier**. A **crozier** is a shepherd's staff carried by Bishops. We learnt that the Bible says Bishops should look after their flock, like a Shepherd does.
