Health, Safety and Security

Fire Extinguisher Maintenance

Maintaining your church's fire extinguishers isn't just good practice—it's a legal requirement. Under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety)
Order 2005, the responsible person at your church must ensure all extinguishers are in proper working order. This includes conducting monthly checks of hoses, nozzles, locking pins, seals, pressure dials, and ensuring all labels are intact and legible.



Unless you have a service-free fire extinguisher, such as a P50, it must be professionally serviced each year by a BAFE-accredited company. Generally, extinguishers have a lifespan of about five years, with CO2 models lasting up to ten years if maintained correctly. No fire extinguisher should be in use for more than 20 years.

Balancing Welcoming Spaces with Security

As many churches remain open during the day, it's important to find a balance between creating a welcoming space and protecting your valuable assets. This is a good time to review your church's security.

Simple steps like conducting an inventory of valuables, securing collection boxes, and ensuring keys are locked away can make a big difference. For added security, consider installing CCTV systems, available through Parish Buying in the Audio Visual section. Witness Through Heritage: St Mary's Journey into Digital Storytelling

The Church of England has once again <u>partnered with Farewill</u> to offer a free online will writing service. Nearly 20% of wills in the UK are now produced by a will-writing company, and because there are no appointments to be made, or time to be taken off work, it's simple to arrange and you are guided through the process. There's no danger of the final will being invalid as they are always checked by qualified solicitors. There is no obligation for people to leave a gift to their local church, but many do – over £3m has been left to local churches through Farewill since 2021.
