

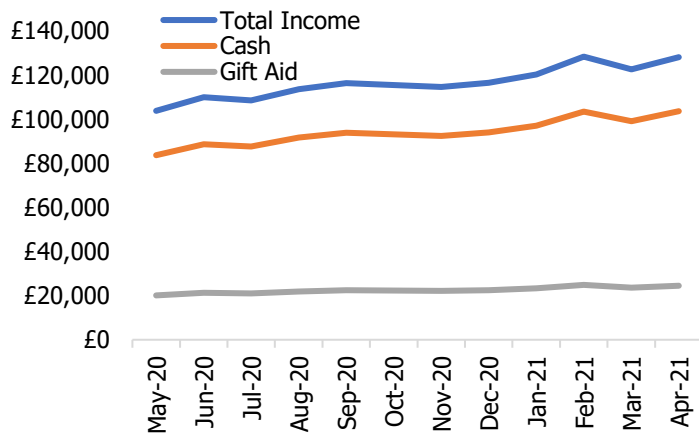


PGS Income: 1st March 2021 - 1st April 2021

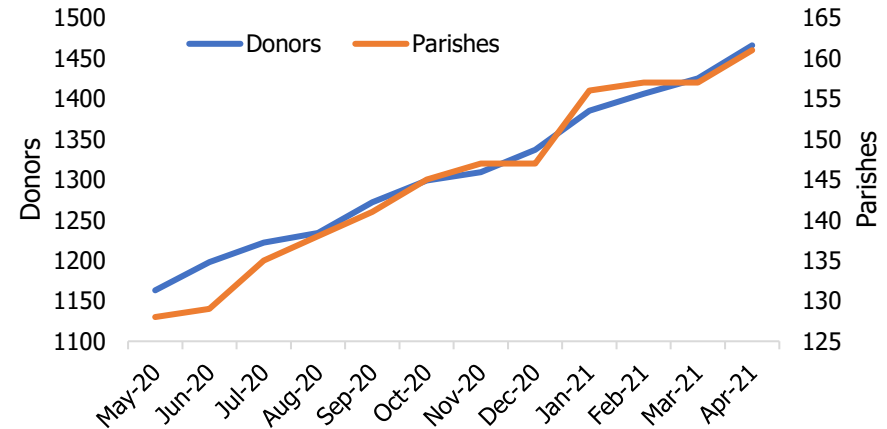
PGS income grew by 4% from the month previous, in tandem with 41 additional donors giving through the scheme. Average giving per week per giver (excluding Gift Aid) via PGS is £15.44, compared to the national PGS average of £16.77.

PGS Coverage: Up to 14th April 2021

Total parishes registered on the scheme has grown to 188. Sudbury deanery has the highest sign-up rate (68%), with Clare and Lavenham close behind (61%). Clare and Lavenham deanery feature the joint highest number of parishes signed-up (17). PGS coverage across the diocese rose to 42%.
